In addition to funding, employers can also add flexibility to your schedule while you complete your degree or help you identify opportunities to apply your new skills on the job. Scheduling a conversation with your human resources (HR) representative is a great way to start exploring your options.

How to approach the support conversation

Before you contact your HR department, make sure you do your research. Find out if your company has an educational benefits program or has sponsored individuals in the past — and familiarize yourself with these efforts. You should also know as much about our program as possible so you can answer any questions that may arise. Review information about our program at negociosenlinea.egade.tec.mx/en/mba.

We urge you to begin this process as early as possible to ensure you're prepared once classes begin.

Schedule an appointment

Plan a meeting with your supervisor or HR representative. You should be prepared to discuss the program, identify the reasons why you want to earn this degree and how your newfound skill set can benefit the company in the short and long term.

Develop a pitch

Make a list of the reasons why earning your degree will make you more valuable to your organization. Think about issues your department or company is facing or new initiatives they're working on and explain how the skill set you'll gain will help you alleviate these issues or enhance the initiatives. Be sure your objectives and reasoning are clear and that you are prepared to discuss specifics.

Ensure all questions are answered

Let your employer know that they can speak with an EGADE Business School representative if they have any questions about the program or about the application process.
